## SKYTEAM AT MOSCOW SHEREMETYEVO TERMINAL 3

SkyTeam continues to expand its global network to provide a smooth travel experience for its passengers, and is planning for a collocation at the new Sheremetyevo International Airport Terminal 3.

A major SkyTeam hub, the multi-year project at Moscow Sheremetyevo has resulted in a state-of-the-art terminal that utilizes the most advanced technology and airport processes.

In addition to greater convenience and higher quality service for passengers, the collocation at Sheremetyevo Terminal 3 will maximize airport facility utilization and help participating member carriers share costs.

## TIMELINE

SkyTeam's presence at Moscow Sheremetyevo will develop throughout 2009:

- **Mid August** – Sheremetyevo Terminal 3 opens to passengers as the first flights operate from the terminal
- **Early September** – SkyTeam member airline Aeroflot flights transfer from Terminals 1 and 2 to Terminal 3
- **Early November** – Participating SkyTeam member airlines will relocate out of Terminal 2 and will be fully operating out of Terminal 3

## SEAMLESS CONNECTIONS

Sheremetyevo Terminal 3 was designed to accommodate a large quantity of daily passengers efficiently and effectively. Once completed, Terminal 3 is expected to serve 12 million passengers annually.

A key differentiator of Terminal 3 is the international and domestic flight combinations within one terminal, providing passengers seamless transfers. In fact, international flight transfers will take an average of 40 minutes – the lowest minimum connection time in Russia – while international to domestic flight transfers will take an average of 60 minutes.

By 2015, Sheremetyevo Terminal 3 is expected to increase passenger capacity to 15 million annually.
